27th TEAMSTERS CONVENTION DELEGATES NEWS June 25th – June 30th, 2006

Teamsters General President Jim Hoffa opened the Teamsters 27th International Convention declaring that the union continues to make history with an unprecedented focus on expanding Teamster power through growth. “We must set our sights on a bigger and stronger Teamsters Union,” Hoffa said. “We will move this union forward. We will do it together.”

The delegates worked on many issues important to the Union members and they passed several resolutions while at the convention:

+ Delegates overwhelmingly passed a resolution to utilize the power of the Graphic Communications Conference of the International Brotherhood of Teamsters to strategically organize Quebecor World, Inc. workers. Quebecor World is the second largest publicly traded printing company in the world.

+ Michigan Congressman Pete Hoekstra declares that government oversight must end. Rep Hoekstra called the Teamsters Union the “voice of America’s workers.” Hoekstra said the Teamsters Union, under the federal oversight of a consent decree since 1989, has earned the right to be free from government supervision.

+ A new provision prohibiting discrimination on the basis of sexual orientation was added to language in the Constitution that already forbids membership discrimination on the basis of race, color, religion, sex, age, physical ability and national origin.

+ Delaware Senator Joe Biden praised the Teamsters for the union’s tireless fight on behalf of working Americans and urged organized labor to remain vigilant against the growing onslaught of raging corporate greed.

+ General Secretary-Treasurer C. Thomas Keegel reported that the union is in outstanding fiscal health. Keegel promised to work tirelessly to secure the union’s future by building Teamster power through organizing.

+ The Teamsters Union won a card-check agreement at UPS Freight, providing a major boost to the Teamsters organizing efforts at the former Overnite Transportation.

+ Teamsters scored a major victory after UPS agreed to the union’s demand to come to the bargaining table to begin early contract negotiations for the 2008 NMUPSA.

+ Delegates committed the union to continue its fight in Congress and at the bargaining table to protect Teamsters’ retirement security amid the pension crisis in the United States.

+ Delegates committed the union to continuing the fight to keep dangerous Mexican trucks off US roads until they meet the same stringent federal safety requirements as required in the United States.

+ Convention Delegates passed a resolution to build on Teamster power in the global supply chain to strategically organize port drivers at major national ports.

+ Former US Senator John Edwards indicated the labor movement is the best antipoverty program in the United States and the Teamsters are leading the way in the fight for workers in America. “It was the union that helped build the middle class of America,” said John Edwards> “Organizing is crucial to the future of the labor movement, and politicians need to support the cause.”

+ Delegates overwhelmingly passed a resolution to work in solidarity with FedEx workers across the country to secure their right to freely join the Teamsters Union without pressure or intimidation.
